#### 3DAAA Secretary's Report June 2018 - May 2019

In this financial year has presented its challenges.

Our review of the Course Setters Training with the objective of creating three levels of proficiency:

Level 1 Club Course Setter

Level 2 Club, Special & Sanctioned Range Setter &

Level 3 National Range Setter to enable more flexibility for clubs and the association to manage setting up safe and enjoyable 3D ranges.

This has been trialled and is being re-visited to modify on feed-back from the trainers and participants.

#### Nationals 2018

2018 saw the committee decide on listening to members concerns and we split the presentations for the Sunday night event, this was top allow members that wished only to attend the presentations for the National Event were done earlier in the evening, and those members wishing to attend the dinner and National Presentations for the year were later in the evening. Whole this initially raised some member concerns, without trying change, we cannot move forwards, the committee welcomed the concerns members presented and used this information to work on the plans that they had put in place – as a result this flowed well and the presentations were at full capacity.

#### Nationals 2019

We have prepared the paperwork and finalised approval with NSW Forestry & Local Government for Nationals to be run at the BIG 4 at Nambucca Heads.

Last year's National's saw one of our Bear targets stolen, to alleviate this problem this year the committee has purchased some trial cameras purchased from our Sponsors so that the areas can be monitored.

We look forward to an improved Nationals in 2019.

#### 3D Targets

The committee working with Tony Knight has now put on offer a range of quality targets approved by 3D AAA at a more affordable price. This has been of great value to clubs that face the challenge of setting up.

#### **Sponsors**
